Dear Mr. Hoffman:

Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney PC ("Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney" or the "Firm") is pleased to accept your request to assist the Town of Chevy Chase (the "Town") in government relations matters. In accordance with our Firm's procedures, this consulting agreement (the "Agreement") confirms the terms on which Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney will provide federal government relations services ("Services").

This Agreement will be valid from February 24, 2014 through February 23, 2015.

Non-legal Services Only

The Services furnished pursuant to this Agreement are consulting services only and are <u>not</u> legal services. The Town understands that this Agreement does not establish an attorney-client relationship between the Firm and the Town. Accordingly, the confidentiality protections and conflict of interest restrictions of the Lawyers' Rules of Professional Conduct and the attorney-client privilege do not apply to the Services. This means that the Firm may provide legal representation to a client in a matter directly adverse to the Town, including litigation.

If the Town wishes to engage the Firm to provide legal services, it will be necessary to enter into a separate engagement agreement covering the terms of our legal representation.

Billing Matters

The monthly retainer for our services is \$29,000 per month, beginning February 24, 2014.

We will provide a monthly statement. Monthly billings also will include expenses incurred in connection with each Service matter. Expenses include items such as travel costs, delivery/messenger services, photocopy, telephone and fax charges, computerized research service charges, word processing/computer charges, and secretarial and other staff overtime charges, if applicable. Certain of these charges may include an adjustment above cost for administrative expenses and overhead incurred by the Firm to provide the billed service. Disbursements in excess of \$500 will normally be forwarded to the Town for direct payment. As is usually the case, disbursement charges may not be current at the time of each monthly billing and will be billed later. Statements are prepared and processed by our accounting department. If you have questions concerning a statement, please call Jim Wiltraut at (202) 452-7943.

Payment is due upon receipt of our invoice. The Firm reserves the right to impose interest at a rate equal to one and one-half percent (11/2%) per month on any outstanding balance that remains unpaid for more than 30 days after receipt of the invoice. The Firm also reserves the right to decline to continue to provide services to clients who do not pay within the guideline without making mutually acceptable arrangements for delayed payment. By signing this Agreement, the Town confirms its understanding of and agreement with the foregoing.

Compliance with Federal Lobbying Disclosure Act

In accordance with the Federal Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995, as amended, the Firm has filed an initial report registering as a lobbyist for the Town with the Secretary of the Senate of the United States and the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives. The registration form requires disclosure of the specific Federal issues lobbied, the House(s) of Congress and Federal agencies to be contacted, any affiliated companies that are contributing to payment for lobbying services, and foreign entities affiliated with the Town, if any, that have a direct interest in the outcome of the lobbying activity. The Firm will also be required to file quarterly reports with Congress to update the initial registration information and to disclose the total income accrued during the quarterly period from the Town for Federal lobbying activities. The reports filed by the Firm will be publicly available on websites maintained by the House and Senate. We will provide the Town with copies of our reports on request.

Confidential Information

The Firm will treat as confidential the Town's proprietary, sensitive and confidential information which may be disclosed to the Firm in connection with this Agreement ("Confidential Information"). Except as necessary to perform the Services and comply with applicable law, including the registration and reporting requirements of the Federal Lobbying Disclosure Act, the Firm will not disclose the Town's Confidential Information to third parties without the Town's written consent. The term Confidential Information does not include information about the Town which is publicly available (through no fault of the Firm or its personnel). The Firm's obligations with respect to the Town's Confidential Information shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.

This engagement established the written permission for the Firm to share information about this engagement with Alexander & Cleaver (A&C) Professional Association and Chambers, Colon & Hartwell, LLC (CC&H). The Firm will establish the above outlined confidential information requirements with both A&C and CC&H.

Records Retention

At the Town's request, we will deliver the documents and property the Town has provided the Firm and documents and materials prepared for the Town in providing the Services. We may elect to retain a copy of portions of the file at our expense. We may withhold our records if there is a breach of this Agreement. In accordance with the Firm's records retention program, we will retain for seven years any files that the Town does not request. We reserve the right to dispose of any documents or other materials after seven years following the conclusion of our Services without further notice to the Town.

Public Information

The Firm sometimes identifies clients in various public communications including (but not limited to) press releases, the Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney website and brochures used to describe the Firm and its capabilities. We ask that your signature on this letter also acknowledge your consent to including the Town's name in these communications.

This Agreement will govern the Services performed by the Firm on behalf of the Town commencing with the date the Firm first performed the Services. Even if this Agreement does not take effect, the Town will be obligated to pay the Firm the reasonable value of the Services the Firm performed for the Town. The Firm will have no obligation to provide the Services until a signed copy of this Agreement is returned to us.

Supporters of Md. light rail line outraged over politically connected lobbyist

The suburban town of Chevy Chase, Md., today will decide whether to sign a new contract with a legal firm it hired to lobby against the Purple Line light-rail project -- amid objections from critics who say the deal represents a conflict of interest.

The Town Council of Chevy Chase will vote on a plan to award a legal team from Buchanan, Ingersoll & Rooney that includes Bob Shuster, the brother of House Transportation and Infrastructure Chairman Bill Shuster (R-Pa.), an 18-month, \$360,000 contract to fight the proposed light-rail line.

The town began paying the firm \$20,000 per month in December, lobbying records show. But proponents of the long-debated rail project said Chevy Chase should not continue to retain the firm's services given Shuster's relationship to the powerful T&I Committee chairman.

"Openness promotes better decision-making, and the town's goal should be to set the standard in" transparency, said John Gill, a Chevy Case resident and member of the advocacy group Action Committee for Transit.

On Monday, ACT demanded that Chevy Chase postpone its vote in order to hold another public hearing on the issue. The town first announced its plans to pay Buchanan, Ingersoll & Rooney an additional \$360,000 at a meeting on Jan. 8.

But members of the Town Council dismissed the group's claims and said they plan to proceed with the vote.

"As long as Bob Shuster does not lobby his brother, there is no legal conflict of interest," said David Lublin, the Town Council's treasurer and a former Chevy Chase mayor.

Shuster declined to comment, but Buchanan, Ingersoll & Rooney issued a statement defending his work on the project,

"Bob has been lobbying for 20 years. Many of his clients ask him to develop strategies for transportation projects across the country, so it is not surprising that he would be asked to assist in such a project," the firm said. "He tells all his clients (including this one) prior to being retained that he does not and will not lobby his brother."

A spokesman for Bill Shuster did not return calls seeking comment. The brothers' father, former Rep. Bud Shuster (R-Pa.), served as chairman of the House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee in the late 1990s.

Bob Shuster has never held public office, though he did work for the Pennsylvania State Senate and former Rep. William Clinger (R-Pa.). Shuster also served on the transportation transition teams for former Pennsylvania Govs. Tom Ridge (R) and Ed Rendell (D).

Still, Buchanan, Ingersoll & Rooney said that Chevy Chase's decision to hire Shuster was not politically motivated.

"The Town of Chevy Chase feels that the Purple Line is an inferior project with abundant and obvious flaws, and they hired our firm to bring voice to those concerns," the firm said.

The Purple Line has been a hot topic of debate in Maryland political circles for almost 30 years, with the bulk of opposition centered in and around Chevy Chase, one of the wealthiest communities in the state.

The 16-mile, \$2.2 billion Purple Line would link Montgomery and Prince George's counties in the suburbs of Washington, D.C., with connections to Metrorail, the MARC commuter rail line, Amtrak and local buses. The Maryland Transit Administration is currently seeking up to \$900 million in private financing to help pay for the project. The state expects to select a private partner late this year or in early 2015.
