Opposes toll lanes: Opposes plans for private company to build toll lanes on I-270 and the Beltway.

MARC trains & Purple Line: Supports all-day MARC trains as high priority and did not oppose the decision to build the Purple Line.

No new highways: Opposes building expensive, destructive new highways like M-83, Observation Drive Extended, and Norbeck/Georgia interchange.

Housing near transit: Supports building more housing near transit, including 2- & 3-family homes.

Safe streets: Supports making streets safe for walking & cycling, even if it slows down car traffic.
