SUBJECT: 355 & 270/495 ROADWAY DESIGNS

The National Naval Medical Center, Bethesda, Maryland met with you and Shirley Contracting Company, LLC on Wednesday, July 8, 2009 by the request of Montgomery County to review roadway design alternatives. Based on our relationship with Montgomery County, we did attend the meeting. During the meeting we expressed our initial concerns with the proposal to include:

- a. Lack of a clearly defined problem that Edgemoor Real Estate Services and Shirley Contracting Company, LLC were attempting to resolve.
- b. Failure to provide any organized and detailed traffic study to justify the roadway design alternatives.

Furthermore, the National Naval Medical Center stated that we could not proceed any further regarding discussion of these designs until these preliminary questions were addressed satisfactorily.

On Monday, July 18, 2009, Mr. Jeff Miller, Transportation Program Manager was approached by Mr. John Zulick, Deputy Officer in Charge of Construction OICC, Bethesda - NAVFAC Washington. Mr. Zulick proceeded to inform Mr. Miller about a meeting with Vice Presidents' of Clark Construction on Thursday, July 9, 2009. During that meeting, Clark Construction presented the aforementioned roadway design alternatives for consideration. Mr. Zulick, unable to represent the National Naval Medical Center in his current capacity, spoke to Mr. Miller at his next available opportunity to relay the events of the meeting.
