

The Sierra Club of Montgomery County and Action Committee for Transit will co-sponsor a District 4 Candidate Forum on Tuesday, March 31st, at 7:30pm – 9:30pm at John F. Kennedy High School, 1901 Randolph Road, Silver Spring, Maryland.

The forum will raise voters' awareness of issues and candidates' opinions on transportation, land use, livable/walkable communities, climate change, habitat protection/restoration, and other key environmental and quality-of-life issues.

The forum will start promptly at 7:30 pm, with rooms set aside for both Republicans and Democrats, and will end promptly at 9:30 pm. All Democratic and Republican candidates have been invited. Approximately one-third of the questions will come from the audience; two-thirds will come from the Sierra Club and ACT.

Voters in the Democratic and Republican parties will choose their nominees for the seat, vacated by the death of Councilmember Don Praisner, during the primaries on April 21st. The general election follows on May 19th.

Kennedy HS is a 15 minute walk from the Glenmont Metro and is served by the C8 Metrobus and Ride-On Route 10.
